

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Did you know that the South Shore Trinity Preschool is celebrating their 75th Anniversary this year? Over the years, I'm sure many of you have been blessed like I have, to be able to have your children attend there. Throughout all these years, our preschool has enjoyed a fine reputation, not only within our congregation, but also in the community. The people of White Bear Lake know that the South Shore Trinity Preschool is a safe and loving environment for their young children



to learn what it means to be a student, as well as a follower of Jesus.

In fact, just 5 years after South Shore Trinity was founded in 1943, Paster Deterding and the congregation felt it was the time to start a Christian day school. So, in September of 1948, the school began with 19 children, with the kindergarten class meeting in the morning, and the nursery class meeting in the afternoon.

Though efforts to expand the school to other grades were not successful, the school persisted on, becoming the Nursery Day School. Later, the Nursery Day School would become the South Shore Trinity Preschool. In 1956, Mrs. Judy Jarsko (who is celebrating her 101st birthday this month on May 25!) was added to the staff around 1956 and taught until 1984. In 1973, Mrs. Ruth Ann Endicott joined Mrs. Jarsko for two years resigning at the end of the 1973-74 school year. Mrs. Ruth Cordes joined Mrs. Jarsko in September 1974 and served until May 1993. The South Shore Trinity Preschool has had a number of other directors in the '90s and 2000s.

In August of 2004, Preschool Assistant Mrs. Ruth Oczak joined the preschool staff, and will be celebrating 20 years of faithful service this August. Mrs. Jolene Erickson is our current Preschool Director/Lead Teacher and has held that position since the fall of 2016.

For 75 years now, our preschool has assisted parents striving to accomplish what God instructs in Deuteronomy 6:4-7a, "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children..." And at South Shore Trinity Preschool, children come to learn who God is and what God has done for them in Jesus—how He came to live, die, and rise again, so that they can be forgiven and saved.

Our preschool, equipped with the Gospel, continues to serve the community today, by offering scholarships to those in need. They offer a significant discount to Disciples of Jesus here at South Shore. And our playground, which was completely replaced in 2019, is enjoyed by our preschool and community members alike.

Please join in giving God thanks and praise for His faithfulness in keeping our preschool open and serving the community and our church family for 75 years! And may this preschool continue to reach out with the Gospel for many years to come.

Blessed by Grace to Give: 2 Corinthians 8-9

Part 1: 2 Corinthians 8:1-7

Introduction:

As God's people, we live every day by the grace of God. He has created and redeemed us. In spite of our sinful ways, God has chosen us by His grace to be His children. Knowing that God has graciously given us our physical and spiritual lives, we are empowered by His grace to show our gratitude. One of the more important ways that we show our thanksgiving is through our giving. We give because God first gave to us. When the time was right, He gave us what we needed the most, a Savior. "But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of woman, born under the



law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons" (Galatians 4:4-5).

Background:

During the time the Apostle Paul wrote his two letters to the church in Corinth, the Jewish Christians in Jerusalem were experiencing a severe famine and persecutions for their faith. Paul encouraged the Corinthians to come to the aid of the Christians in Jerusalem by giving generously to them. In 2 Corinthians chapters eight and nine, we read that Paul wanted the Corinthians to finish the offering that they had begun previously. This initial offering was referred to in 1 Corinthians 16:1-4 when Paul sought a collection for believers suffering in Jerusalem. He wrote, "On the first day of every week, each of you is to put something aside and store it up, as he may prosper, so that there will be no collecting when I come" (1 Corinthians 16:2). This verse directs the Corinthians to give to the collection weekly, individually, and proportionately. Each person was to give a portion of his income as he prospered.

Giving Is a Fruit of Grace

2 Corinthians 8:1-5: "We want you to know, brothers, about the grace of God that has been given among the churches of Macedonia, for in a severe test of affliction, their abundance of joy and their extreme poverty have overflowed in a wealth of generosity on their part. For they gave according to their means, as I can testify, and beyond their means, of their own accord, begging earnestly for the favor of taking part in the relief of the saints—and this, not as we expected, but they gave themselves first to the Lord and then by the will of God to us."

The poverty of the Macedonians did not stop or hinder their giving. Filled with God's grace and love, they pleaded for the privilege of giving to support the distressed Christians in Jerusalem. Hearing about the plight of fellow believers, they responded generously with joy. By grace, the Macedonians were willing to deny themselves even basic necessities and potential comforts and pleasures that money would have provided them for the joy of extending God's grace to others. Experiencing God's grace, they gave "beyond their means." God's grace empowered them to give and to give generously.

In his book Making Change, Ken Hemphill wrote, "Joy and generosity are twins...Joy comes from the knowledge of sins forgiven and the contemplation of God's generosity on our behalf...Joy thus leads one to generosity, and generosity in return gives one joy...Miserly people are miserable people, and generous people are joyous."



Closing Thoughts: When we give faithfully and generously, we mirror the true nature of God. Through our faithful giving, we reflect His likeness. God's giving nature is revealed to us through His Word. He gives physical life, and, through Jesus, He gives life forever with Him. Through grace and faith, which He supplies, we are enabled to give. "And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work" (2 Corinthians 9:8), including giving. Giving is an important part of being a Christian.
